Request for Expression of Interest (REOI) for Selection of ERP Vendor and Implementation Partner for Supply & Installation of an Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) System

- 1. The economy of Bangladesh has achieved significant economic progress since independence. In recent years the country has been able to maintain impressive track record on economic growth and overall development. Bangladesh has the potential to grow at an even faster rate.
- 2. "Digital Bangladesh" is a part of the government's Vision 2021 which promises a prosperous and equitable middle-income Bangladesh. - 6. Interested ERP Vendors and Implementation Partners should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The short-listing criteria are:
 - (a) General experience of the Firm(s);
 - (b) Experience in similar assignments of compatible size, complexity and technical specialty in the required area;
 - (c) Financial Soundness of the firm; and
 - (d) Staffing and logistics of the firm.
- 7. ERP Vendor must have been in the field of ERP software business for a minimum of ten (10) years (Documentary proof required)
- 8. ERP Vendor shall demonstrate average annual business turnover of at least USD 10 billion from software business in each of the last ten (10) years. (Documentary proof required)
- 9. ERP Vendor shall demonstrate availability of liquid assets of at least USD 1 billion. (Documentary proof required)
- 10. ERP Vendor and Implementation Partner must have legal presence in Bangladesh for post-Implementation support. (Documentary proof required)
